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India and Easy Access

- Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) during 2017 were 10.18 million with a growth of 15.6% over same period of the previous year.

- During 2017, a total of 1.7 million foreign tourists arrived on e-Tourist Visa registering a growth of 57.2%.

Participating Hotel Lodhi



A 7-minute walk from Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium metro station, this ritzy hotel is decorated with contemporary Indian artwork and is 10 km from the 17th-century Red Fort.

Featuring elegant decor and high-end furnishings, the sleek rooms come with free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, and balconies with private plunge pools. Suites add living rooms and dining areas. Room service is available.

Amenities include 2 restaurants, a cigar lounge and a library. A tranquil spa offers steam rooms, as well as beauty and massage treatments. There's also a fitness centre, and an indoor pool with a poolside cafe.

Participating Hotel Lalit



This ritzy hotel is 2 blocks from lively Connaught Place, a 7-minute walk from the Shivaji Bridge railway station and 1.6 km from Jantar Mantar, an 18th-century astronomy complex.

Refined rooms have flat-screen TVs and DVD players, plus minibars and desks. Upgraded rooms have iPod docks, free Wi-Fi and access to an exclusive lounge. Suites have living areas; some include original art, in-room bars and butler service. Room service is available.

A free breakfast buffet is served in a 24-hour restaurant. There are 5 other eateries, plus a bar and a funky nightclub. Other amenities include a spa, a yoga studio, a fitness centre and an outdoor pool.

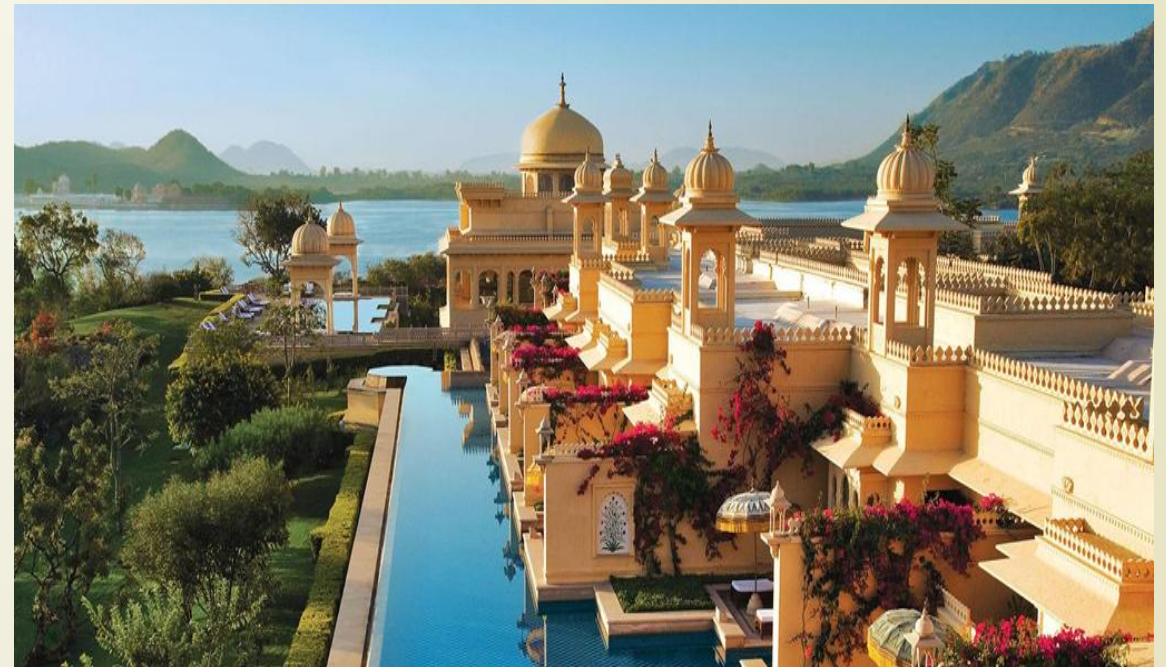
